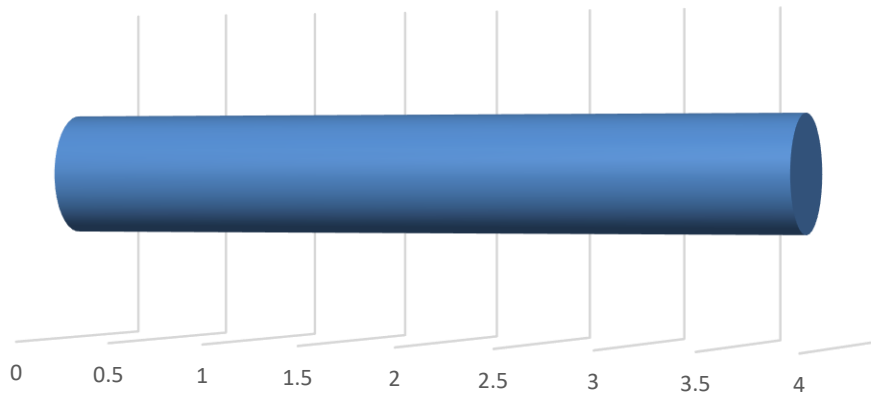

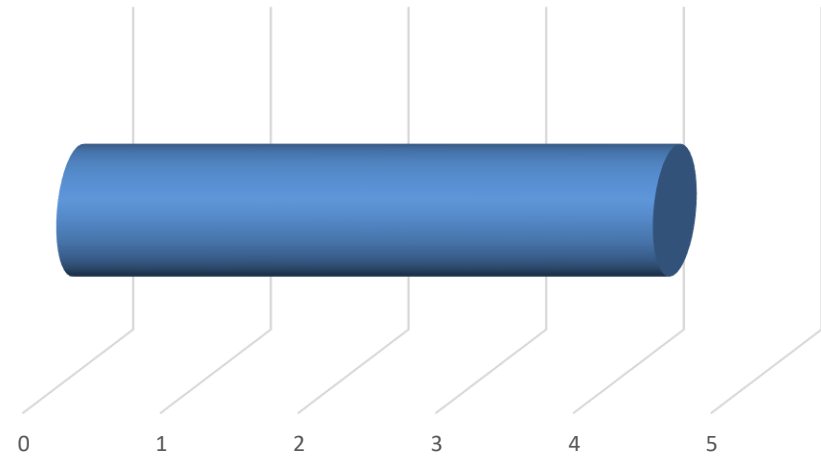

The level of the event on meeting your expectations

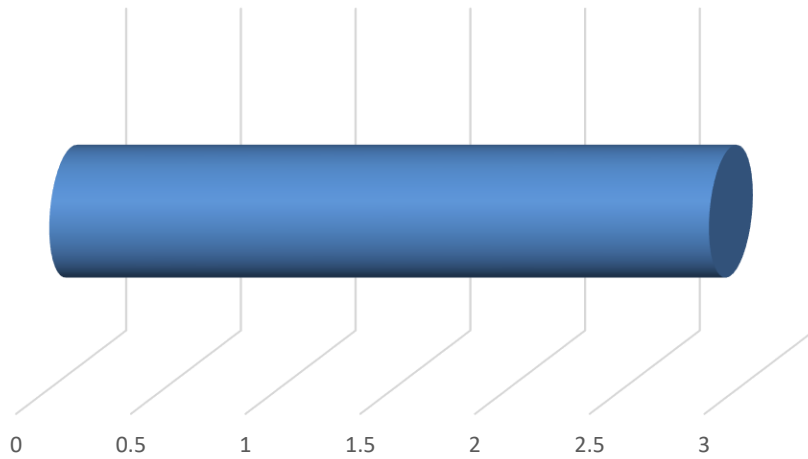


Evidence of clear planning of the event

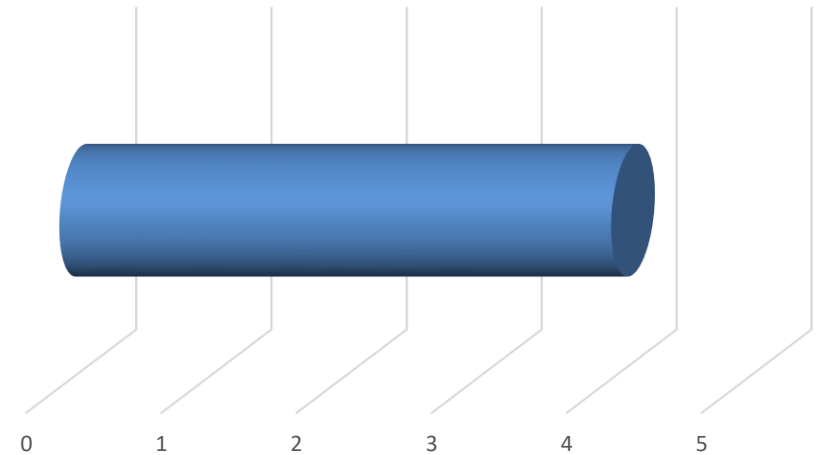


# Evaluation of the ME

The event was well promoted

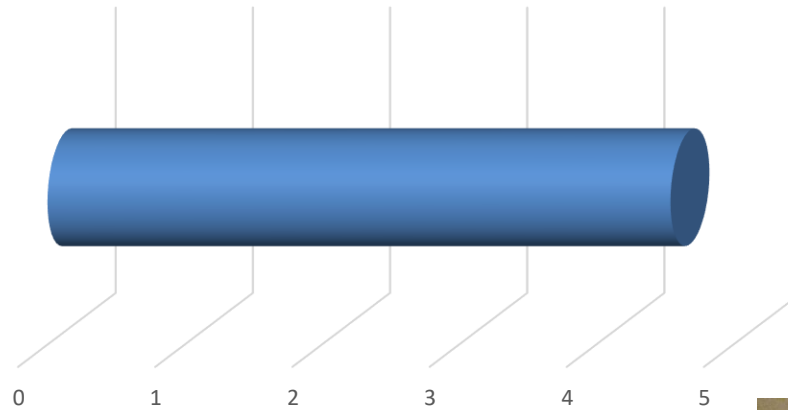


The topics covered were relevant for me

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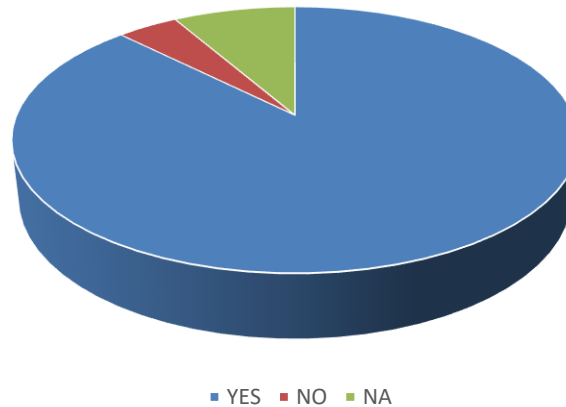
